Our Programme Priorities

Inspired by UNDP's Signature Solutions, a new Country Programme (2022 – 2026) in partnership with Governments, Civil Society, private sector and other development partners focuses on four priorities.

Social Resilience and Inclusion

The Social Resilience and Inclusion portfolio seeks to improve the social and economic resilience of vulnerable groups such as women, youth, persons with disabilities, persons living with HIV and AIDS and those employed in the informal economy.

Citizen Safety and Security and Rule of Law

UNDP's citizen safety and security portfolio seeks to improve the effectiveness of relevant institutions for justice service delivery and national capacity to reduce crime and violence.
